AGREEMENT

BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT OF FINLAND AND THE ORGANISATION FOR ECONOMIC CO-OPERATION AND DEVELOPMENT ON PRIVILEGES AND IMMUNITIES OF THE ORGANISATION IN FINLAND

THE GOVERNMENT OF FINLAND AND THE ORGANISATION FOR ECONOMIC CO-OPERATION AND DEVELOPMENT (hereinafter called the "Organisation"),

CONSIDERING that the Government of Finland on 28th January, 1969 acceded to the Convention on the Organisation for Economic Co-Operation and Development of 14th December 1960;

HAVING REGARD to the Supplementary Protocol No. 2 to the Convention on the Organisation for Economic Co-Operation and Development and, in particular, its paragraphs (a) and (d);

HAVE AGREED as follows:

Article 1

The Organisation, its officials, and representatives to it of the Members shall enjoy, in the territory of Finland, the legal capacity, privileges, exemptions and immunities provided for in Articles 1 to 19 of the Supplementary Protocol No. 1 to the Convention on the Organisation for European Economic Co-Operation of 16th April, 1948.

Article 2

This agreement shall come into force on the date on which the instrument of acceptance by the Government of Finland is deposited with the Secretary-General of the Organisation.

IN FAITH WHEREOF, the undersigned duly authorised thereto have signed this Agreement.

DONE at Paris, this eighteenth day of March, nineteen hundred and sixty nine, in duplicate, in the English and French languages, both texts being equally authentic.
