

What is this questionnaire about?

The student who brought this questionnaire home was selected to participate in the Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA), a research study which focuses on the mathematical, scientific, and reading literacy of students who are 15 years old. The study is organised by the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) and it surveys students from over 80 different countries.

In the PISA study, students are asked to answer questions concerning science, mathematics, reading, and creative thinking, and to provide information on their background, beliefs and opinions on issues that generally relate to schooling and their careers. As part of the study, we are also surveying students' parents on a number of similar topics including:
