## Informal waste workers in circular economy transitions: between dispossession and exploitation?

Informal workers and enterprises are disadvantaged due to lack of credit and commercial finance, data, digital tools and social respect

Market-based CE transition creates room for newer, wellresourced players to enter the recycling and repair industry, displacing or subordinating informal workers

Market opportunities splinter and stratify informal workers, on ethno-racial and gendered lines
