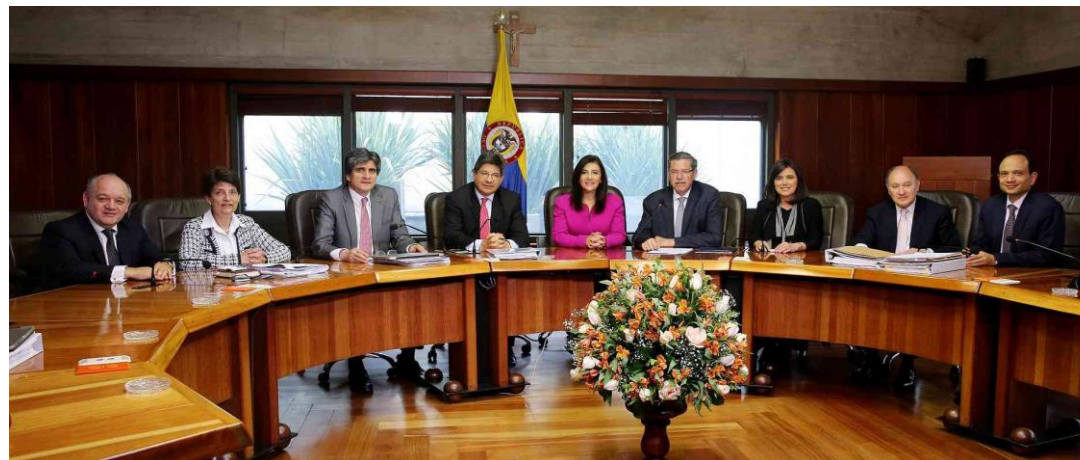

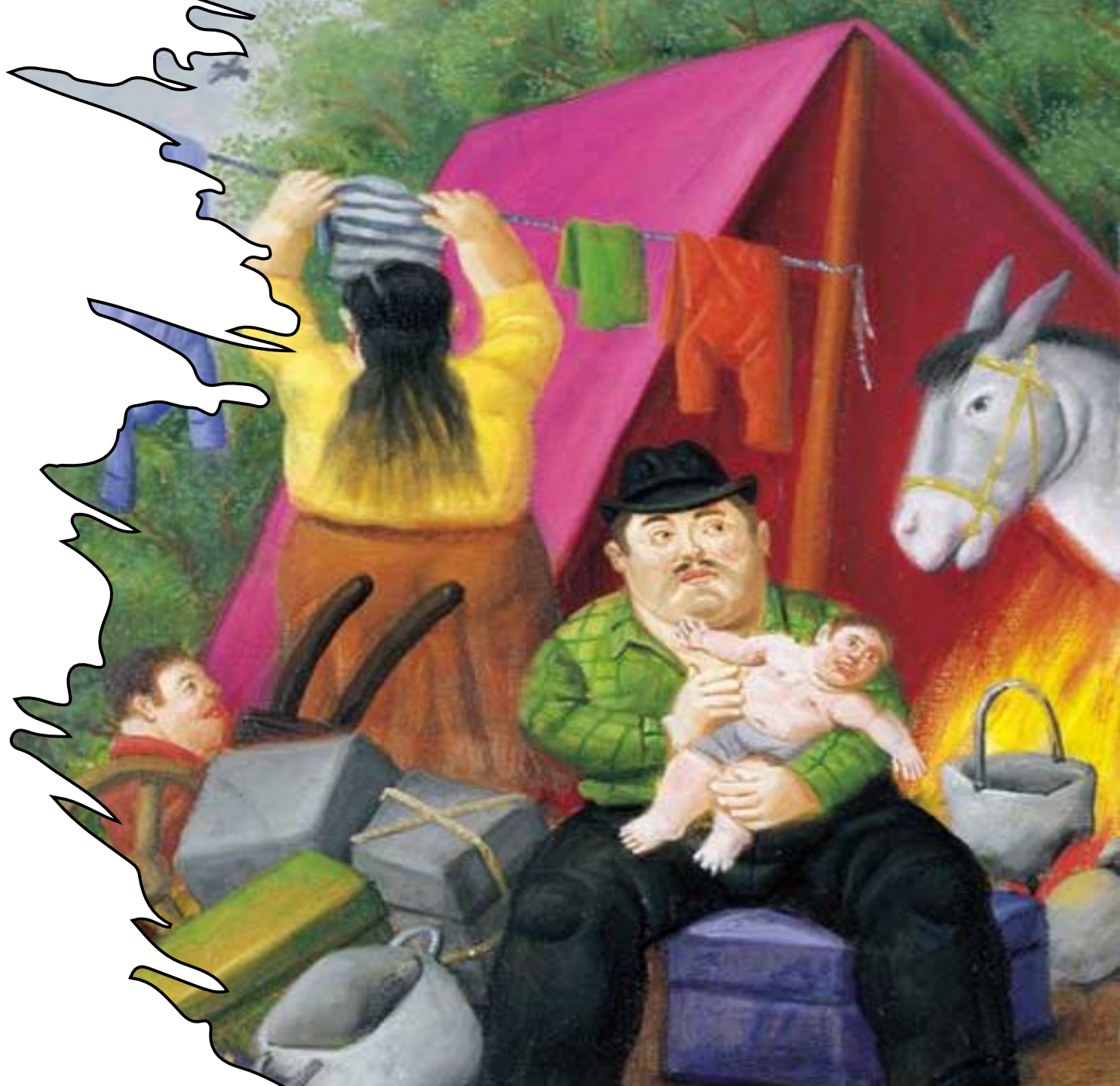
The Constitutional Court of Colombia recognizes forced internal displacement caused by mankind alterations to the environment (climate change)

Judgment of the Constitutional Court of Colombia T-123 de 2024



The Constitutional Court of Colombia recognizes internal forced displacement caused by mankind alterations to the environment. This decision establishes the obligation of the State to provide comprehensive protection and assistance to the victims of this phenomenon, establishing an important precedent for the protection of the rights of the people affected by environmental damages in Colombia.
